Operational Highlights

- Announced Pharmaceuticals and Medical Device Agency (PMDA) approval in Japan for expanded labeling of the FARAPULSETM Pulsed Field Ablation (PFA) System to include treatment of drug refractory, symptomatic persistent atrial fibrillation (AF).
- Commenced enrollment in the AGENT DCB STANCE trial to assess the safety and effectiveness of the AGENT™ Drug-Coated Balloon (DCB) in patients with previously untreated coronary lesions, compared to standard of care percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) treatment with drug-eluting stents and/or balloon angioplasty.
- Published in JAMA Neurology outcomes from the five-year INTREPID study demonstrating sustained benefits of deep brain stimulation in people with moderate to advanced Parkinson's disease, including improved motor function and quality of life.
- Completed asset acquisition with Elutia, Inc. to acquire the antibiotic-eluting EluPro™ BioEnvelope and the CanGaroo® Envelope, designed to prevent certain post-operative complications for devices such as pacemakers and defibrillators.
- Announced agreement to acquire Nalu Medical, Inc., developer of the Nalu Neuromodulation System, which is designed to use peripheral nerve stimulation to deliver targeted relief for adults living with severe, intractable chronic pain of peripheral nerve origin - subject to customary closing conditions.

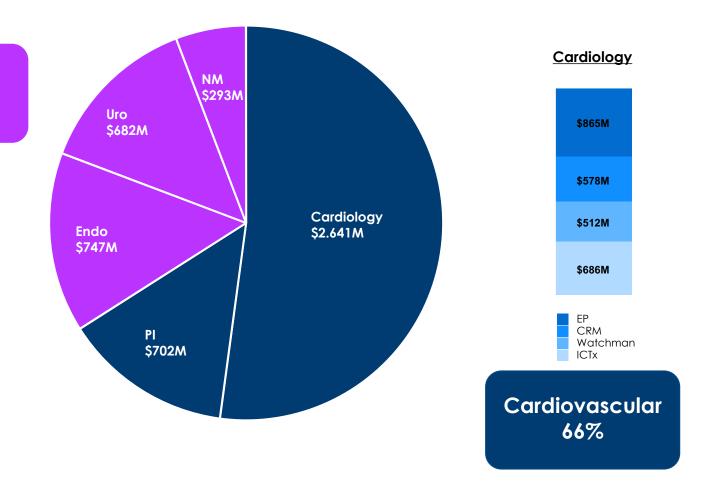






Q3 2025 Reported Net Sales: \$5.065B Net Sales by Business; Segment Percentage of Total Net Sales

- Endoscopy: Global net sales +10.1% as reported, +9.0% operational*/organic*
 - Strong double-digit growth in our anchor products including MANTIS™, AXIOS™ and OverStitch™.
- Urology: Global net sales +28.1% as reported, +27.5% operational* and +5.4% organic*
 - Growth in the quarter was driven largely by the Stone Management franchise.
- Neuromodulation: Global net sales +9.1% as reported, +8.6% operational*/organic*
 - Brain franchise grew low-double digits, supported by five-year results from Intrepid study, which demonstrated sustained benefits of DBS in people with moderate to advanced Parkinson's disease.
 - Pain franchise grew high-single digits led by strong double-digit growth in Intracept™.

Q3 2025 Highlights

- Cardiology: Global net sales +24.0% as reported, +23.1% operational*/organic*
 - Interventional Cardiology Therapies: Global net sales +3.7% as reported, +2.9% operational*/organic*
 - Includes the impact related to the worldwide discontinuation of the ACURATETM valve, which had prior year global sales of approximately \$50M per quarter.
 - Coronary therapies grew low-double digits, driven by AGENTTM DCB and the global imaging portfolio.
 - WATCHMAN: Global net sales +34.8% as reported, +34.6% operational*/organic*
 - Growth was fueled largely by strong concomitant uptake in the U.S.
 - Cardiac Rhythm Management: Global net sales +3.0% as reported, +1.8% operational*/organic*
 - In Core CRM, our low-voltage business grew low-single digits and our high-voltage businesses declined low-single digits.
 - The Diagnostic franchise grew low double-digits, led by continued above-market performance with our LUX-DxTM ICM device.
 - Electrophysiology: Global net sales +64.2% as reported, +62.8% operational*/organic*
 - Growth led by FARAPULSETM and supported by ramping adoption of the OPALTM HDx mapping system.
- Peripheral Interventions: Global net sales +16.7% as reported, +15.8% operational* and +6.3% organic*
 - Peripheral Interventions growth driven by strength in the U.S., partially offset by China VBP.
 - In Venous, double-digit growth was driven by strength in VarithenaTM and EKOSTM, partially offset by a low single-digit decline in arterial driven by our participation in China VBP.
 - Interventional Oncology and Embolization franchise grew double digits across the portfolio, driven by our broad embolization and cancer therapies portfolio, with notable strength in the cryoablation franchise.
